Academic Program

(Fall or Spring - 16 weeks)

Program fee includes:

Tuition for 4 courses = 4 TCNJ credits (16 US credits)

Students enroll in four courses during the semester. All courses are instructed in English. The courses combine lectures and class discussion with a variety of on-site visits to European political and economic institutions, German and multinational corporations, and locations of historical and cultural importance – all of which play an integral role in creating a unique study abroad experience.

Courses taught at the CEPA campus have been designed especially for this study abroad semester program. Students will enroll in additional courses taught at the SRH University Heidelberg. Additionally, students have the option to take intensive German language courses (all levels) as part of their semester program.

Housing & Meals

Student accommodation is included in the program fee. Students will live in CEPA's student residence on campus or in shared apartments nearby. The CEPA campus is centrally located in a safe, residential neighborhood of Heidelberg, requiring only a short bus ride to classes at SRH University Heidelberg or a short walk for shopping and other activities. Student rooms are fully equipped and have access to a shared kitchen and shared bath facilities. The CEPA campus has classrooms, wi-fi internet access, a library, computer labs, laundry facilities, and a student cafe/lounge.

Meals

Students will have access to the SRH and University of Heidelberg student cafeterias as well as the option to use the shared cooking facilities at the CEPA campus. Four to five additional group meals are also included in the program, depending on the semester.

Transportation

The public transportation system in Heidelberg and the surrounding area is excellent, convenient and easy to use. There are fast, direct connections from campus to the city center every ten minutes.
